

AMENDMENT TO WILEY READ AND PUBLISH AGREEMENT

Amendment as of January 1, 2023 with Wiley internal number 9839.2 to the Wiley Read and Publish Agreement dated March 15, 2021 (the “Agreement”), by and between John Wiley & Sons, Inc., a New York corporation, 111 River Street, Hoboken, New Jersey 07030 (“Wiley US”, and collectively with its affiliates “Wiley”) and National University of Ireland Maynooth, Maynooth University, whose principal address is at Maynooth, Co Kildare, Ireland (“Maynooth University”), acting on its own behalf and as non-exclusive agent on behalf of the other Members of the Consortium.

In signing this Amendment, the parties agree that the following terms shall amend and supersede the terms of said Agreement as follows:

1. The following Consortium Members shall be added to constituent members of the Consortium listed in Schedule 4.

- Mary Immaculate College
- Dundalk Institute of Technology
- Atlantic Technological University (ATU)
- Institute of Art, Design and Technology
- South East Technological University (SETU)
- Munster Technological University
- Technological University of the Shannon: Midlands Midwest

2. Section 2.a of Schedule 1 under the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. Access & Hybrid Journal Publishing Fees.

- a. Maynooth University, as agent on behalf of the Members shall pay a single, annual, non-refundable commitment fee for the Access Right for the Licensed Materials included under **SCHEDULE 2: Licensed Material** and for the Hybrid Journal Publishing Right during each Contract Year specified below (the “Annual Access & Hybrid Journal Publishing Fee”), as follows:

3. Section 3 of Schedule 1 under the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. **Gold Journal Publishing Fees.** Maynooth University shall pay for the publication of Eligible Articles in Gold Journals from a Gold APC fund an amount as specified in the table, which will fund the WOAA balance administered by Maynooth University (the “Gold APC Fund”). The APC levied by Wiley for open access publishing in Gold Journals will be at the Wiley APC for the journal, which Wiley has discounted for the benefit of the Members as set forth in the table below (“Gold APC Discount”). Wiley will deduct APCs due for each such Eligible Article from the total annual Gold APC Fund for the Members on a first-come first-serve basis until the Gold APC Fund for the Contract Year is depleted. If Members spend less than the Gold APC fund each year, then Wiley will transfer the excess funding towards the agreed Gold APC fund for the following Contract Year, up to the last Contract Year of the Agreement.

- a. Funding requests are approved by Maynooth University or Member on submission of the article. If the article is accepted for publication, and the APC Fund is depleted, and the funding request is approved by Maynooth University or Member, Wiley will invoice Maynooth University directly in accordance with Wiley’s invoicing schedule and Maynooth University shall pay such invoice having already approved the funding request.


Except as provided by the Amendment herein stated, all terms and conditions of the Wiley Read and Publish Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
